



CEREAL BOX TURKEY ACTIVITY

To make this Boomer Turkey from a cereal box you will need:

- Empty Cereal Box
- Construction Paper (brown, red, yellow, orange and green)
- Glue Stick
- Printer Paper
- Scissors
- Marker

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Tape the open top of the cereal box closed, and cut the cereal box in half lengthwise.
2. Measure 4 inches from each side, and cut at the 4-inch marks to remove the center. Set the center pieces aside for later.
3. Tape the two edges together.
4. Glue brown construction paper to outside of the box.
5. Cut out feathers using colored construction paper.
6. Using a marker, write what you are thankful for on the feather, and then attached them to the outside of the back of the box.
7. Cut out Boomer's face inside the turkey costume, and color it in. Using glue, attach Boomer's face to the extra cardboard to help it stand up. Then, glue his face to the front of the box.
8. Make a "Happy Thanksgiving" sign. Cut out the hands using brown construction paper, and then attach them to the sign. Glue the hands and sign to the front of the box.
